WHEREAS all members declare having read the draft regulation and renounce the reading;

**WHEREAS** the Mayor has mentioned the purpose of the regulation and its significance, with exemption from reading.

## **RESOLUTION #16-12-188**

## APPLICATION FOR MINOR ZONING VARIATION AT 11, RUE DESROSIERS

The request is to allow a distance of 1.56 meters from an existing accessory building to an existing residential main building in confliction of the regulations which provide a minimum distance of 2 metres between an accessory building and a main residential building.

Also the request is to allow a distance of 0.8 meters between an existing gallery and a front line of property in confliction of the regulation which provides a minimum distance of 1.5 metre between a gallery and a front line of property.

CONSIDERING THAT the application meets the objectives of the plan of development;

**CONSIDERING THAT** the application of this regulation caused severe prejudice to the applicant;

**CONSIDERING THAT** the request is considered to be minor;

**CONSIDERING THAT** the authorisation of such request for a minor zoning variation does not affect the enjoyment by the owners of the neighbouring buildings of their right to property;

**CONSIDERING THAT** the application is covered by an article of the zoning regulations that may be the subject of a minor zoning variation;

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Martine Bouchard and resolved unanimously that the Town of Métis-sur-Mer accepts the request for minor zoning variation demanded and specified in the public notice.

8.2 Application for minor zoning variation at 375, rang 3 est.

## **RESOLUTION #16-12-189**

On the other hand, the Council expresses a condition to which this derogation is only for the existing buildings and in the case of a reconstruction of one of these, the future building will have to be consistent with all of the applicable by-laws.
