RESOLUTION 19-12-164

ADOPTION OF REGULATION #19-137 LOWERING THE SPEED TO 55 KM/H ON RUE MCLAREN

CONSIDERING THAT paragraph 4o of the first subsection of section 626 of the Highway Safety Code (L.R.Q., v. C-24.2) allows a municipality to set by regulation the minimum or maximum speed of road vehicles in its territory;

CONSIDERING THAT a notice of motion accompanied by a draft regulation has been previously given by Councillor Ms. Rita D. Turriff at the council meeting held on November 4, 2019;

CONSIDERING THAT copy of this regulation was available no later than two (2) days prior to this meeting with the Town's Records Access Officer;

CONSIDERING THAT copy of this regulation was available to the public at the beginning of this session;

IN CONSEQUENCE, it is proposed by Councillor Ms. Rita D. Turriff and unanimously resolved:

That Regulation 19-137 be adopted as submitted to the members of the Council.

7.3 Adoption of regulation 19-139 authorizing a supervisor to drive in a road vehicle during a snow removal operation on a public road with a snowblower.

RESOLUTION 19-12-165

ADOPTION OF REGULATION 19-139 AUTHORIZING A SUPERVISOR TO DRIVE IN A ROAD VEHICLE DURING A SNOW REMOVAL OPERATION ON A PUBLIC ROAD WITH A SNOWBLOWER

CONSIDERING THAT Sections 497 and 626 of the Highway Safety Code (C 24.2) give a municipality the power to adopt a by-law authorizing, on all or part of a road owned by the Town, a supervisor to drive in a vehicle in front of a snowblower;

CONSIDERING THAT the Town of Métis-sur-Mer wishes to take advantage of these rules in snow removal operations with a snowblower with a net mass of more than 900 kg of public roads, located in residential areas where the speed limit is 50 km/h or less, as listed in attachment A as an integral part of this By-law;

CONSIDERING the need to provide by this By-law the criteria to ensure the safety of children, residents and workers in the execution of snow removal operations on public roads with a snowblower;

CONSIDERING THAT a notice of motion accompanied by a draft regulation has been previously given by Councillor Mr. Simon Brochu at the council meeting held on November 4, 2019;

CONSIDERING THAT copy of this regulation was available no later than two (2) days prior to this meeting with the Town's Records Access Officer;

CONSIDERING THAT copy of this regulation was available to the public at the beginning of this session;

IN CONSEQUENCE, it is proposed by Councillor Mr. Luc Hamelin and unanimously resolved:

That Regulation 19-139 be adopted as submitted to the members of the Council.

9.1 Agreement between MRC de la Mitis and the Town of Métis-sur-Mer - water rescue service.

RESOLUTION #19-12-166

AGREEMENT BETWEEN MRC DE LA MITIS AND THE TOWN OF MÉTIS-SUR-MER - WATER RESCUE SERVICE

CONSIDERING THAT the MRC has the equipment to carry out water rescue interventions, but does not have the human resources to provide this service;

CONSIDERING THAT the Town of Métis-sur-Mer has the expertise in water rescue and wishes to continue to carry out this service.

FOR THESE REASONS,

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Martine Bouchard and unanimously resolved that the Council of the Town of Métis-sur-Mer wishes to have an agreement with MRC of La Mitis to ensure that the organization, operation and administration of an intervention service in water rescue for the entire territory of the MRC of La Mitis and names the Mayor as well as the Director General to sign the agreement.

9.2 Agreement to purchase equipment in common.

RESOLUTION #19-12-167 AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT IN COMMON

CONSIDERING THAT an authorization is required to make an agreement with the Towns of Métissur-Mer and Mont-Joli, the municipalities of Grand-Métis, La Redemption, Les Hauteurs, Padoue, Price, Sainte-Angèle-de-Mérici, Saint-Charles-Garnier, Saint-Donat, Sainte-Flavie, Saint-Gabriel, Sainte-Jeanne d'Arc, Saint-Joseph-de-Lepage, Saint-Octave-de-Métis and the MRC of La Mitis, to make tenders in common, for the purchase of three (3) generators and various equipment that can be used during disasters.

It is proposed by Councillor Ms. Rita D. Turriff and unanimously resolved that the Métis-sur-Mer Town Council authorizes the Mayor and the Director General to sign on behalf of the Town of Métissur-Mer an agreement with Mont-Joli, the municipalities of Grand-Métis, La Redemption, Les Hauteurs, Padoue, Price, Sainte-Angèle-de-Mérici, Saint-Charles-Garnier, Saint-Donat, Sainte-Flavie, Saint-Gabriel, Sainte-Jeanne d'Arc, Saint-Joseph-de-Lepage, Saint-Octave-de-Métis and the MRC of La Mitis, to make tenders in common, for the purchase of three (3) generators and various equipment that can be used in the event of a disaster.
